Independent research about the circulatory system.
History	<p>In History, pupils will begin to learn about World War 2. They will be exploring:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Why Britain declared war on Germany and who was Winston Churchill. What happened during the Battle of Britain. What was the Blitz and why did it take place? Why were people evacuated? Why was food rationed in 1940? <p>And finally, how did the conflict change society during and after the second world war.</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Research, research and more re-research all about World War 2. Talk to parents and grandparents, watch documentaries and read about the events that went on from 1939.
