English	 Write a character description based around a character from the Malorie Blackman novel, Pig Heart Boy. Write a recount diary based around Pig Heart Boy. Write a non-chronological report about the circulatory system. 	 Encourage your child to read independently at least four times a week. Read with your child to promote a love of reading.
Maths	 Understanding place value with numbers up to 10,000,000 Consolidate and further develop use of the 4 operations with increasingly complex numbers. 	Use TT Rock Stars to consolidate times table knowledge.
Science	In Science, pupils will be investigating the topic 'Animals, including humans'. ◆ Learn the functions of the main parts of the circulatory system ◆ Describe the effects of diet, exercise, drugs and lifestyle on how the body functions	 Discuss how the heart works. Independent research about the circulatory system.
History	In History, pupils will begin to learn about: The history of the Stockton to Darlington railway line and the impact this revolution had on our local area.	 Discuss the history of Teesside and aim to visit some of the famous in- dustrial sites that Tees Valley is re- nowned for.
Art &	 In D.T. , Y6 will be aiming to design and make a stuffed toy. Use pen and ink to create detailed anatomical drawings. 	◆ Look at how different stuffed toys are constructed.
Music	♦ In Music, pupils will be improvising and composing, recognising the connection between sound and symbol and learning the notes of the pentatonic scale (D, E, G, A + B).	 ◆ Ask what is the difference between improvisation and composition? ◆ Discuss what they have composed in lessons.
