









This half term we will be learning the following things. Here are also some useful hints and tips for helping at home.

English	<p>In English, pupils will:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Write narrative poetry about WWII Write a radio broadcast set in WWII Write a procedural text to inform somebody what to do in the event of an air raid Write a discussion about evacuation during WWII 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Encourage your child to read independently at least four times a week. Read with your child to promote a love of reading.

Science	<p>In Science, pupils will be investigating the topic 'Living Things and Their Habitats'.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Describe how living things are classified into broad groups according to common observable characteristics and based on similarities and differences, including micro-organisms, plants and animals 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Discuss what they have learned in that day's science lesson. Can they explain how living things are classified? 
History	<p>In History, pupils will begin to learn about World War 2. They will be exploring:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Why Britain declared war on Germany and who was Winston Churchill. What happened during the Battle of Britain. What was the Blitz and why did it take place? Why were people evacuated? Why was food rationed in 1940? <p>And finally, how did the conflict change society during and after the second world war.</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Research, research and more research all about World War 2. Talk to parents and grandparents, watch documentaries and read about the events that went on from 1939.
D.T.	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> In D.T. , Y6 will be aiming to design and make a stuffed toy. 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Look at how different stuffed toys are constructed.

Latin	<p>This year, we have chosen to teach Latin because of the rich opportunities that come with learning this ancient language. As well as being a fascinating language in its own right, knowledge of Latin helps to develop literacy skills. Through Latin, children develop their knowledge of spelling and vocabulary through learning Latin roots of English words and deepen their understanding of grammar.
