




## Nursery Spring 2 Half Termly Overview for Parents and Carers

# Ready. Respectful. Safe.



This half term we will be learning the following things.

- Theme: Down on the farm



- Maths -  
Numbers 6 – representing, subitising, ordering and comparing.  
Height and Length – comparing, sorting, and ordering.  
Mass – balancing and comparing.
- Phonics –blending and initial sounds.
- Outdoor Thursdays
- World Book Day – 6<sup>th</sup> March
- Farm animal visit – 20<sup>th</sup> March
- Red Nose Day – 21<sup>st</sup> March

Here are also some useful hints and tips for helping at home.

- Continue to share a book with your child to develop their love of reading.
- Can your child show you representations of numbers 1-5?
- Go on a Spring Walk and discuss the changes your child can see.
- Practise forming some recognisable letters of their name.
- Can your child identify the initial sound in their own name?
- Can your child tell you the life cycle of a flower or chick?
- Ask your child to find objects that are  
• smaller/taller/shorter/bigger than they are? Can they use key words to identify the size of the objects against themselves i.e. the door is bigger than me.
